Great Keppel Island, we take a day cruise to the Island enjoy a Glass Bottom Boat Cruise. This tour is a quiet, relaxed alternative for those wishing to view the wonders of the reef coral viewing and spectacular marine life without even getting their feet wet.

Cooberrie Park Wildlife Sanctuary, Yeppoon zoo and home to snakes, crocodiles, koalas, kangaroos, native birds, dingos, monkeys, emus, possums and more.

Torres Straight Islander Village – the Torres Straight Islanders have a unique culture of their own. The informed tour guide explains the Islanders traditional lifestyle and beliefs. During the tour of the Torres Straight Islander Village, the tour guide takes the visitors through a giant Dugong complex which displays artefacts and building materials of the Torres Straight Islander People.

Djarn Djarn Dancers, translated into Aboriginal means “mens Dance Group” is Dreamtime own traditional dance group.
